

Online Registration for Youth Events

On the GBC website (www.gracea2.org), click on Event Registration on the right side of the page.

A list of events will drop down. Click on the one you want.

A page with Event Details will display. Click on Register Now.

At this point, you have three choices (you will have this choice again on the next page):

1. Login to your existing egiving account
2. Sign Up for an egiving account
3. Register without an egiving account

(With an egiving account you may pay with your credit or debit card, or with an ACH bank transfer; without an egiving account you may pay with your credit or debit card.)

Register WITHOUT an Egiving Account

1. Enter your registration information. In some cases there will be several choices of payments, in other cases, only one. Enter your student's name, your name, and your email address. Click Continue.
2. (You will again be given the option to optionally Login to/Sign Up for your egiving account.)
3. Enter your credit/debit card information and click I Authorize This Transaction.

Register for an Event WITH an Egiving Account

1. Once you have logged in or signed up, you have a choice between Make a Transaction and View Upcoming Events. Choose **View Upcoming Events**. (Make a Transaction is used for making donations to GBC.)
2. A calendar will appear. At the bottom, upcoming events will be listed.
3. Click on Register for this event for the appropriate event.
4. Enter your registration information. In some cases there will be several choices of payments, in other cases, only one. Enter your student's name, your name, and your email address. Click Continue.
5. You may choose a Saved payment option or enter a new one (credit, debit, or bank account). Click I Authorize This Transaction.

Do I Have to Register for an Egiving Account?

NO! You may register and pay for events using a credit or debit card without registering for an egiving account.

The advantages to registering for an egiving account are:

1. You may pay with an ACH bank transfer in addition to using credit/debit cards.
2. Your bank account/credit/debit information is saved so you do not have to enter it each time. (This is considered to be more secure than entering it each time.)
